Heart Healthy Pizza and the Food Pyramid

Many consider pizza to be junk food, and, boy howdy, are they misinformed. It all depends on what you order. If you order the right things, a pizza can be as close to an exact duplicate of the food pyramid as one dish can be.

Start with the grains and cereals at the base of the pyramid: that's what the crust of a pizza is. Next is the fruits and veggies part of the pyramid: order pizza sauce. and any of the fruits (tomatoes, pineapple, etc) or veggies that you want to make up that layer. Next, go light on some meats and the cheese, and you have a duplicate of the food pyramid.

We use a high-quality provolone cheese, and high-quality means high butterfat content. So to make a low fat pizza, stay away from double cheese; asking for "light cheese" is a way to keep good flavor and cut way down on the fat. All the meats that we use are the leanest of their kind, but they do contain some fat. But most everything else is low fat, so we've made the list at right of all the things that you can order as much of as you want and still be low fat.


Vegans: there are no animal products ____ at all in our dough or sauce. Start with a no-cheese pizza (we do it all the time) and add any veggies you want.

Gluten Free Crust! It's only in the 12" (because that's what they make) and it's a couple of bucks more (our cost). Also, it's prepared in a restaurant with LOTS of flour, so vou'll ingest trace amounts of flour just walking in the joint, even though we use separate utensils for the

gluten-less pizzas. But if trace amounts are okay, we use the same toppings and cheese and sauce, and they aren't half bad at all. We have a few customers who order the gluten-less pizzas just because they like them, even though

they are fine with flour.
